Dear Mayor Udine:

The State Land Planning Agency has completed its review of the comprehensive plan amendment adopted by the City of Parkland (Amendment No. 12-1ESR) by Ordinance Numbers 2012-04, 2012-05, and 2012-06. We have reviewed the amendment in accordance with the expedited state review process set forth in Sections 163.3184(2), (3) and (5), Florida Statutes (F.S.), and identified no provision that necessitates a challenge of the Ordinance adopting the amendment.

If this plan amendment is not challenged by an affected person, the amendment will become effective 31 days after the State Land Planning Agency notified the local government that the plan amendment package was complete. If this plan amendment is challenged by an affected person, the amendment will not become effective until the State Land Planning Agency or the Administration Commission enters a final order determining the amendment to be "In Compliance." No development orders, a development permits, or land uses dependent on this amendment may be issued or commence before it has become effective.
