Program Details and Requirements

1. Applications will be accepted for review and processing from October 1st to September 30th of qualifying fiscal year.
2. One approved application per property owner/resident or business per Fiscal Year for the lifetime/duration of the program will be processed.
3. No person or entity will be eligible for an Environmental Sustainability Incentive or payment unless he/she has fully completed the application requirements as approved by the City Manager or qualified designee.
4. For an applicant to be considered for payment, purchases and/or services must be rendered on/before September 30th of qualifying Fiscal Year. Only completed applications received by 5:00 p.m. September 30th of qualifying fiscal year shall be considered for qualification of payment during the fiscal year.
5. Required inspections must be called in to 954-757-4165. The City Arborist will inspect the property within a week of call in date.

Program Criteria - EXOTIC INVASIVE VEGETATION REMOVAL

1. Applicant must own a residence and/or parcel within the City of Parkland. Property/parcel must be located within Parkland city limits.
2. A site assessment and post inspection will be performed by City Staff to verify the amount and type of exotic invasive vegetation and the site condition after the removal is complete. Applicants are required to meet minimum landscape requirements per city code of ordinances for site improvement.
3. The applicant will be required to provide documentation of the removal and replacement (**if applicable*) upon request for post-inspection.
4. One approved application for the removal of invasive exotic vegetation per property/household per Fiscal Year for the duration and lifetime of the program. Upon submittal of the approved application, the Parkland resident or property owner can schedule a pre-inspection. Call 954-757-4165 to schedule.
5. Upon complete approval of the application, inspection and budget process, the applicant would be eligible to recover a max of 25% or up to \$20,000 for HOA's, \$6,000 for individual properties one acre and over, and \$2,500 for individual properties under one acre of the total cost for the removal and/or (*if required*) replacement of the listed Exotic Invasive Vegetation (EIV). *Note: Applicant property owners that abut a right-of-way, but are < 1 Acre may be eligible to receive up to \$1,000 towards the replacement of plant material that meet approved streetscape requirement.
